Protect Yourself from Fraudulent Messages



Cyber-attacks and data theft are real threats to all Canadians. Protect yourself by staying vigilant and always remember:

- ◆ LCU will never ask for personal or account information by email or text message.
- ◆ Don't click on links or attachments in messages that seem suspicious or come from someone you don't know.
- ◆ Contact your financial institution if you're suspicious about any information or request.

LCU Education Loans

If you are enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution, you are eligible to apply for a student loan. The loan can be structured as a loan or line of credit based on your needs and preference. Interest is charged at a reduced rate of Prime + 1.00% with interest-only payments due monthly while you are attending school. Repayment terms are flexible and your first payment can be up to six months after the completion of your studies.
